Good Afternoon Cher,

Just wanted to summarize the call we had last Thursday.

On Feb 11, the VCA for SWMU 31 & 127 is scheduled to kick off. The Corps of Engineers at Omaha will be Service Center and Baywest will be the prime contractor for the project. Once completed, the collected data will allow Cannon to have a better handle on the amount of contaminated soils that need to be removed.

Once the SWMU 31 and 127 CMS/CMI is completed, Cannon will review the data and forward to NMED for review. Cannon would like to accelerate the remediation/clean-up phase as staffing and coordinating allows.

Our initial distribution of FY08 monies funded the remediation/clean-up project for FTA-4 (SWMU 109). When

construction began for two temporary C-130 Hangars, which are in an area adjacent to SWMU 31, Cannon decided to shift priorities from the FTA-4 project to the SWMU 31 and 127 remediation/clean-up project.

When FY08 supplemental funds are distributed or fallout monies become available, the FTA-4 Remediation/Clean-up is at the top of Cannon's project list.
