The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received the Department of the Air Force's (Permittee) *Final No Further Action Report for SWMU 101 - Sewage Lagoons*, dated July 2008. NMED has accepted the document for technical review as a Class 3 Petition for Corrective Action Complete Review in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.F NMAC. 

If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify the NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.

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If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. James Valdez, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds.
