This letter is the 3rd quarter CY 08 (Jul-Sep) Progress Report for Solid Waste Management Units (SWMU) and Areas of Concern (AOC) sited on Cannon Air Force Base (CAFB) and Melrose Air Force Range (MAFR), as required per paragraph 2.5.3.d Quarterly Reports, Hazardous Waste Permit, Environmental Protection Agency, Identification Number New Mexico 7572124454, dated 17 Oct 03.

Activities for the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Corrective Action Program (RCAP) and other significant permit activities for the 3rd quarter of 2008 are as follows:

- a. CAFB submitted invoice to DFAS for Hazardous Waste Bureau (HWB)-CAFB-08-002, dated 9 Sep 2008, for NMED's review and approval of the *Final No Further Action for SWMU 101 – Sewage Lagoons*.
- b. CAFB submitted invoice to DFAS for HWB-CAFB-08-003, dated 9 Sep 2008, for NMED's review and approval of the *Final Letter Report, Rev 1, VCA, SWMU 31 and SWMU 127, Jul 2008*.
- c. CAFB submitted invoice to DFAS for HWB-CAFB-08-004, dated 9 Sep 2008, for NMED's review and approval of *14 Corrective Action Proposals, Jul 2008*.

Projected RCAP activities for the 4th quarter of 2008: Cannon scoped, costs and obligated contracts for CAFB and MAFR Long Term Monitoring (LTM) and remedial actions at SWMU 31, 109 and 127.
