
Dear Colonel Leahy:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Cannon Air Force Base's Class 3 permit modification requests, titled *FINAL No Further Action Report for SWMU 101 – Sewage Lagoons* (July 2008) (HWB-CAFB-08-002) and *Corrective Action Complete Proposals* (July 2008)(HWB-CAFB-08-004).
