The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Cannon Air Force Base's request for a Class 3 permit modification, titled *Corrective Action Complete Proposals*, dated October 2008. The NMED has made a determination that the submittal is administratively complete. The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC require the assessment of fees after an application is deemed administratively complete. The fee invoice is attached to this letter. Upon receipt of the payment, the NMED will initiate a technical review of the submittal in accordance with 20.4.2.201.B(3) NMAC.


