Ms. Frischkorn,

Mr. Gerald Pelfrey, Natural Resources, Cannon AFB, asked me to pass the Subject information to you. The attached was compiled from a combination of three sources: tables (especially Table 2) in a February 2006 letter from NMED addressed to Col. Posner, a historic UST database maintained at Cannon AFB, and Real Property records of Cannon AFB. Some of the information goes back to the 1980's.

We didn't know the depth or detail expected, but the attached is readily accessible and we did not want to delay a response any longer. The dozen AOC's without readily accessible documentation requires additional file searching and investigation and will require additional time. Please keep in mind that although it may be difficult to locate definitive historical documentation of removals/closures/demolitions at this time, there was sufficient supportive evidence at one time to grant No Further Action (NFA) or Not Requiring Corrective Action status (NRCA) by the State. (See Table 2 of previously referenced letter.)

We will continue to search our hard copy records over the next few weeks in hopes of locating more positive data in support of NFA or NRCA and to identify more complete documentation as Cannon AFB transitions to a Long Term Management posture.
