The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received the Department of the Air Force's (Permittee) *Long-Term Monitoring and Maintenance Work Plan for Landfill No. 3 (LF-03/SWMU 105), Landfill No. 4 (LF-04/SWMU 104), Landfill No. 25 (LF-25/SWMU 97), and Sewage Lagoons (SWMU 101)*, dated December 2008. NMED has accepted the document for technical review as an investigation report in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC. NMED will provide the Permittee with a full technical review after the appropriate fees have been received. The fee invoice is attached to this letter. Upon receipt of the payment, NMED will initiate the technical review of the report in accordance with 20.4.2.201.B(3) NMAC.



Payment is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice in accordance with 20.4.2.301.C NMAC. If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify the NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. James Valdez, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds.


