





The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received, on January 28, 2010, Cannon Air Force Base's (Permittee) response to NMED's Notice of Disapproval (NOD) for the *Draft Final Work Plan for Final Closure of Solid Waste Management Units 70 and 71, Cannon Air Force Base, New Mexico, June 2009* (Response to NOD). The Permittee failed to provide two copies of a revised work plan and an electronic red-line strike out version of the revised work plan that shows all revisions made to the plan as required by the NOD.

In its Response to NOD, the Permittee indicated that it is having difficulty locating documents that are likely archived and temporarily unavailable while the Permittee revises and upgrades its administrative record. Instead of providing an incomplete response to the NOD, the Permittee should have requested an extension, providing adequate justification for requesting the extension.

NMED reminds the Permittee that it does not review or approve draft documents. Any documents submitted as draft will be considered final under 20.4.1 and 20.4.2 NMAC.

In the absence of an extension request, the Permittee must submit a revised work plan in the form of two paper copies and one electronic copy and an electronic red-line strike out version of the revised work plan that shows all revisions made to the plan by March 15, 2010.
