Dear Mr. Lancaster:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Cannon Air Force Base's (Permittee) Remedy Completion Report for SWMU 31 AGE Maintenance Facility dated May 2010 (Report). NMED hereby issues this Notice of Approval and provides the following additional direction.

Corrective Action Complete with Controls status can be achieved if the hazardous constituents detected at a SWMU are between residential and industrial New Mexico Environment Department Soil Screening Levels (SSLs). Dibenz(a,h)anthracene and benzo(a)pyrene are present in soil at SWMU 31 in concentrations exceeding residential SSLs, but less than industrial SSLs. The Permittee may petition for Corrective Action Complete with Controls status for SWMU 31.


