On October 19, 2010,  
Cannon Air Force Base  
(CAFB) informed the New

Mexico Environment  
Department (NMED) that  
it had an emergency  
involving unstable haz-  
ardous waste and  
requested that the NMED  
issue an emergency per-  
mit to treat the waste by  
detonation. CAFB's  
explosives experts deter-  
mined that the unstable  
waste posed an imminent  
and significant health and  
safety risk and was  
unsafe to transport on or  
across civilian motor-  
ways.

The unstable waste con-  
sists of one 100-pound  
unexploded ordinance.  
The CAFB explosives dis-  
posal team plans on deto-  
nating the waste onsite  
on or before November  
12, 2010 and will imple-  
ment all necessary safety  
precautions.

Based on all information  
provided and after con-  
sidering the inherent dan-  
gers associated with han-  
dling the unstable materi-  
als, NMED approved an  
emergency permit for  
CAFB to destroy the  
above noted item pur-  
suant to 20.4.1.900  
NMAC, incorporating 40  
CFR 270.61. CAFB must  
also properly dispose of  
any hazardous residues  
that remain after the  
destruction of the waste.
