The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Cannon Air Force Base's (Permittee), May 4, 2011 extension request letter concerning the *Groundwater Monitoring and Annual Landfill Inspection Report; Landfill No. 3 (LF-03/SWMU 105), Landfill No. 4 (LF-04/SWMU104), Landfill No. 25 (FL-25/SWMU 97), and Sewage Lagoons (SWMU 101), dated June 2010*. The Permittee requests a thirty day extension to submit documentation that the subsidence associated with the burial trenches at the former landfills (SWMU 104 and SWMU 105) have been filled and graded in accordance with NMED's February 18, 2011 Approval with Modifications. The need for the extension is the result of a delay in the contract award to have the work completed. The Permittee's have shown good cause and NMED hereby approves the thirty day extension from June 3, 2011 to July 5, 2011.


