

Per our conversation on August 15, 2011 Cannon proposes to prepare a work plan outlining the scope required to bring Landfill 3 (SWMU 105) and Landfill 4 (SWMU 104) into compliance as described in the approved work plan, entitled "*Final Long-Term Monitoring and Maintenance Work Plan for Landfill No. 3 (LF-03/SWMU 105), Landfill No. 4 (LF-04/SWMU 104), Landfill No. 25 (LF-25/SWMU 97), and Sewage Lagoons (SWMU 101)*" Cannon Air Force Base, New Mexico July 2009.

Upon review of the comprehensive surface survey recently conducted, it was noted that more work than originally anticipated is required. In order to obtain funding and to prepare the required Work Plan, Cannon respectfully requests an extension to the previously approved submittal date of September 5, 2011 as referenced in your letter dated June 29, 2011, Approval of Second Extension Request.

Cannon anticipates submitting a work plan to your office for review no later than January 31, 2012 with implementation of the Work Plan three months from date of approval, anticipated May 31, 2012.

Dear Col. Kimball:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Cannon Air Force Base's (Permittee's), June 20, 2011 second extension request letter concerning repair of the covers for Landfills 3 and 4. The Permittee requests an additional 60 day extension to submit documentation that the depressions created by subsidence associated with the burial trenches at the former landfills (SWMU 104 and SWMU 105) have been filled and graded per NMED's February 18, 2011 Approval with Modifications. The need for the extension is the result of a delay in the completion of the comprehensive surface survey to provide accurate data to accomplish the required work. The Permittee's have shown good cause and NMED hereby approves the additional 60 day extension from July 5, 2011 to September 5, 2011.
