The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received Cannon Air Force Base's (the Permittee) Letter *Request for time extension for the Fee Assessment for the Work Plan for Monitoring Well Installation at Landfill No. 25 (LF-25/Solid Waste Management Unit [SWMU] 97)* dated November 22, 2011. The Permittee states that additional time is needed due to the receipt date of the fee assessment (29 September FY 2011). Because of the receipt date, an obligation adjustment request must be processed to use FY 2011 funds in FY 2012 which will result in a delay in payment. The Permittee has shown good cause for the extension. NMED hereby grants a 60-day payment due date extension to the Permittee.


Payment is now due on January 29, 2012, in accordance with 20.4.2.301.C NMAC. If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify the NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.
