Cannon AFB is formally petitioning for a Class 3 Permit Modification per 20.4.1.900 of the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC) incorporating the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), specifically 40 CFR 270.42 (c) to change the status of eight SWMUs from Corrective Action Required to Corrective Action Complete (CAC) based upon the investigative history of each unit. CAC with Controls is proposed for four units (SWMUs 34, 78, 85, and 95) and CAC without controls is proposed for the remaining four units (SWMUs 31, 110, 111, and 112).

Cannon Air Force Base (AFB) submits the *Corrective Action Complete Proposals for Eight Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs 31, 34, 78, 85, 95, 110, 111, and 112), Cannon Air Force Base, New Mexico* for your review. This submittal includes an electronic and hard copy of the document that summarizes the investigative history for each unit. The proposal was originally submitted by Colonel David Piech via transmittal letter dated 6 May 2013. This CAC Proposal serves as the supporting documentation required to render a decision.

If the change in status from Corrective Action Required to CAC with Controls is granted, the proposed Class 3 Permit Modification would move the four SWMUs (SWMUs 34, 78, 85, and 95) from Table 1, entitled "SWMUs and Areas of Concern (AOCs) Requiring Corrective Action" to Table 2, entitled "SWMUs and AOCs Not Currently Requiring Corrective Action".


If the change in status from Corrective Action Required to CAC without Controls is granted, the proposed Class 3 Permit Modification would move the four SWMUs (31, 110, 111, and 112) from Table 1 to Table 2.

The Public Notice for this permit modification request will be published in the legal section of the *Clovis News Journal* on Friday, May 17, 2013, which will initiate the 60-day

public comment period. The public comment period will end on July 16, 2013. A public meeting will be held on June 5, 2013.

Notice of Petition (Proposal) for a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Class 3 Permit Modification at Cannon Air Force Base (AFB), in Curry County, New Mexico (NM). Cannon AFB submitted a Corrective Action Complete Proposal for 8 Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) to the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) that requests a change in corrective action status.

The Permit Modification requests a change in status from Corrective Action Required to Corrective Action Complete with Controls for four (4) SWMUs, including SWMUs 34, 78, 85, and 95.

The Permit Modification requests a change in status from Corrective Action Required to Corrective Action Complete without Controls for four (4) SWMUs, including SWMUs 31, 110, 111, and 112.
