
Dear Colonel Piech:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received Cannon Air Force Base's (Permittee's) January 15, 2013 request for a time extension to submit the Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 109 Remedial Action Construction (RAC) report. The extension is necessary due to contract issues with its former contractor and the need for the Permittee to place the work under the New Mexico Performance Based Remediation contract which is expected to begin in September 2013.
