Dear Mr. Kieling

This purpose of this letter is to inform New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) that the requirement to re-seed Landfill 4, Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 104 is complete. On 22 Oct 13, NMED provided an Approval with Modification letter for the 2012 Biennial Groundwater Monitoring and Annual Landfill Inspection Report. This letter stated that SWMU 104 was required to be re-seeded by 20 Feb 14. Cannon Air Force Base (CAFB) sent an extension request on 23 Feb 14, until the end of Jun 14, for this requirement and the request was approved. On 17 Jun 14, CAFB sent an updated schedule for the re-seeding of landfill 4, indicating the requirement would be met on 30 Sep 14, and documentation would be provided by 30 Oct 14.
