The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received Cannon Air Force Base's submittal titled *Monitoring Well Abandonment, Installation, and Sampling Report LF005 (SWMU 113) and SI101 (SWMU 101)* dated December 21, 2017 and received November 26, 2017. The submittal addresses actions for six wells. NMED has accepted the submittal for review in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC.
