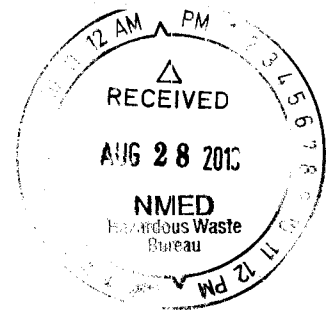

This letter requests concurrence regarding AOC AAA's demolition plan. AOC AAA is currently listed in Table 1 of Cannon's RCRA Corrective Actions Only Permit #NM7572124454. The required Release Assessment (RA) or Investigation Work Plan is due to NMED February 28, 2022.

AOC AAA is building 202, built in 1953, 50'x21' 1050 square feet, concrete structure. Building 202 was once used for storage of Hazardous Material, but is currently used to store miscellaneous office supplies. Building 202 is currently slated to be demolished September-October of 2019. The demolition will involve removing the structure and the concrete pad.

Cannon AFB Spill Manager confirmed no releases have been reported at building 202. Visual inspection of the building did not reveal any discoloration of the concrete floor. Cannon AFB Hazardous Waste Manager confirmed building 202 was not used to accumulate/store hazardous waste.

With your concurrence, Cannon AFB intends on completing the demolition of building 202, and then complete the RA by February 28, 2022.
