The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the Cannon Air Force Base (Permittee) notification for demolition of the structure identified as Area of Concern (AOC) AAA, Hazardous Materials Storage, Facility Building No. 202. The NMED recommends that the release assessment be completed and reviewed by NMED prior to any future construction at the site, while the entire site is accessible to allow for investigation, should any sampling needs be identified by the Release Assessment. In accordance with the RCRA Permit, a Release Assessment Report must be submitted to NMED no later than February 28, 2022.
