The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is in receipt of the Cannon Air Force Base (Permittee) *Project Status Report and Annual Land Use Control Inspection Report for Sites LF001 and LF005* (Status Report) dated November 16, 2020. NMED has reviewed the Status Report and hereby issues this Approval.

The Permittee may proceed with all Landfill LF005 maintenance and repairs activities outlined in Status Report Section 4.0, Conclusions and Recommendations, and the required annual inspections for LF001 and LF005.

A follow-up status report documenting all completed landfill inspections, field activities, maintenance, and repair for LF001 and LF005 must be submitted to NMED for review in accordance with the schedule specified in NMED's July 1, 2020, *Approval with Modifications Project Status Report and Annual Land Use Controls Inspection Report for Sites LF001 and LF005*. Based on this schedule, the next status report documenting landfill inspections and maintenance activities must be submitted to NMED for review no later than **November 30, 2021**.


