
On May 14, 2007, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) conducted a hazardous waste Compliance Evaluation Inspection at Enterprise Field Services, located at 895 CR 7100, Bloomfield. Based on that inspection and review of the information obtained, the NMED has determined that your facility is a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste as defined in the Notification of Regulated Waste Activity Instructions (EPA Form 8700-12). Further, the NMED observed no violations of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC).

No further action is required at this time. However, this letter does not relieve Enterprise Field Services of its obligation to comply with any other applicable laws and regulations.
