On February 6, 2013, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) conducted a hazardous waste Compliance Evaluation Inspection at Kargo Service Center, located at 3103 Princeton, Albuquerque. Based on that inspection and review of the information obtained, the NMED has determined that your facility is a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste, as defined in the Notification of Regulated Waste Activity Instructions (EPA Form 8700-12). Further, the NMED observed no violations of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC).


Kargo Service Center is a vehicle repair and maintenance shop which services vehicles and trailers for all U-haul businesses in the northern part of New Mexico. The facility generates used oil, spent antifreeze, as well as spent lead acid batteries. Kargo Service Center has greatly reduced the amount of hazardous waste by incorporating into it daily practice the use of "Ozzy Juice" and "Ozzy Mats" in their parts cleaner, oil/waste separator and the general maintenance of the shop area.

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No further action is required at this time. However, this letter does not relieve Kargo Service Center of its obligation to comply with any other applicable laws and regulations.
