On June 10, 2013, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) conducted a hazardous waste Compliance Evaluation Inspection at National Security Technologies, LLC, located at 182 East Gate Dr., Los Alamos. Based on that inspection and review of the information obtained, the NMED has determined that your facility is a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste, as defined in the Notification of Regulated Waste Activity Instructions (EPA Form 8700-12). Further, the NMED observed no violations of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC).

National Security Technologies, LLC conducts research & development in x-ray and laser optics for various US Dept. of Energy clients. The facility generates spent fluorescent bulbs, spent electronics batteries and solvent contaminated wipes.

No further action is required at this time. However, this letter does not relieve National Security Technologies, LLC of its obligation to comply with any other applicable laws and regulations.
