Good morning, Janine,

Per your request, I am sending this email to provide the explanation for the shipment of waste by Aerojet on 6/25/2021 from the EMRTC facility in Socorro, New Mexico. As I said during our call, Aerojet shut down all of its operations in Socorro in June 2019. However, at that time, Aerojet had some federal government owned materials at the Socorro facility for which it had not received disposition instructions from the federal government. Aerojet continued to store those materials at the Socorro facility while it awaited instructions from the federal government regarding whether the materials were to be shipped back to the federal government or disposed. Aerojet received those instructions from the federal government a little before June of 2021. Per the federal government instructions, a portion of the stored materials were to be sent for disposal while another portion were to be returned to the federal government. The waste shipment by Aerojet on 6/25/2021 was for the materials that the federal government required be disposed. Aerojet has no other stored materials at the Socorro facility that require disposal, and no operations there. As a result, we do not anticipate that there will be any additional shipments of waste by Aerojet from the Socorro facility.
