Dear Mr. Lovato:

On November 26, 2013, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) conducted a hazardous waste Compliance Evaluation Inspection at Walgreens #3367, located at 8011 Harper Drive NE, Albuquerque. Based on that inspection and review of the information obtained, the NMED has determined that your facility is a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste, as defined in the Notification of Regulated Waste Activity Instructions (EPA Form 8700-12). Further, the NMED observed no violations of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC).

Walgreens #3367 sells groceries, prescription drugs, and a wide assortment of general merchandise. The facility generates hazardous waste from the return of hazardous waste pharmacy prescriptions and damaged goods.

No further action is required at this time. However, this letter does not relieve Walgreens #3367 of its obligation to comply with any other applicable laws and regulations.
