Please be advised that all of EPNG's facilities, with the exception of Roswell Compressor Station, were either CESQG or did not generate any hazardous waste in 1997.

EPNG also received an invoice for Laguna Station (EPA ID Number NMR 000 000 992). EPNG does not need to submit an invoice since it is in the Pueblo of Laguna and is regulated by the EPA.

After my conversation with you on July 22, 1998, EPNG did not receive the Roswell Compressor Station fee invoice and the New Mexico Annual Hazardous Waste Fee Report Worksheet (Form NMED/AHWFR-001) until July 30, 1998. As a result of this and referencing our last conversation on July 28, 1998, EPNG will not be submitting any late fees for the 1997 fee schedule.
