On November 22, 2019 the New Mexico Environment Department ("NMED") provided Mymar Terminal Services ("Mymar") located at 1705 Industrial Drive, Portales, New Mexico, a Compliance Assistance Visit to address potential hazardous waste issues and pollution prevention options. Mymar is a company specializing in dairy trailer transport and dock services for a nearby Dairy Farmers of America facility. The facility generates non-hazardous parts washer solvent, used oil, used antifreeze, waste lead acid batteries, waste diesel fuel, and oily shop towels.

Based on observations and review of the information obtained, NMED has determined that your facility is a Very Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste as defined in 40 Code of Federal Regulations ("CFR") 262.13 and/or a Used oil generator as defined in 40 CFR 279.1 and/or a Universal Waste generator as defined in 40 CFR 273.9 and was in compliance with hazardous waste regulations.

NMED appreciates your efforts to adhere to the Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 New Mexico Administrative Code), which can be found on the Hazardous Waste Bureau website at <https://www.env.nm.gov/hazardous-waste/hazardous-waste-regulation-and-authorization/>.
