On April 10, 2017, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) conducted a hazardous waste Compliance Evaluation Inspection at P-K Tool & Manufacturing Company, located at 2800 Airport Road, Suite D, Santa Teresa New Mexico. Based on that inspection and review of the information obtained, NMED has determined that the facility is a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator of hazardous waste as defined in the Notification of Regulated Waste Activity Instructions (EPA Form 8700-12). Further, NMED observed no violations of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (20.4.1 NMAC).


P-K Tool & Manufacturing Company is a machine shop that conducts metal stamping to produce parts for the automotive and recreational industry. The facility mainly generates used oil and scrap metal. The laser cutting sludge was recently tested and determined to be non-hazardous waste.

This inspection was initiated by a complaint alleging improper disposal of used oil. At the time of the inspection, used oil was being managed properly in 55-gallon drums.
