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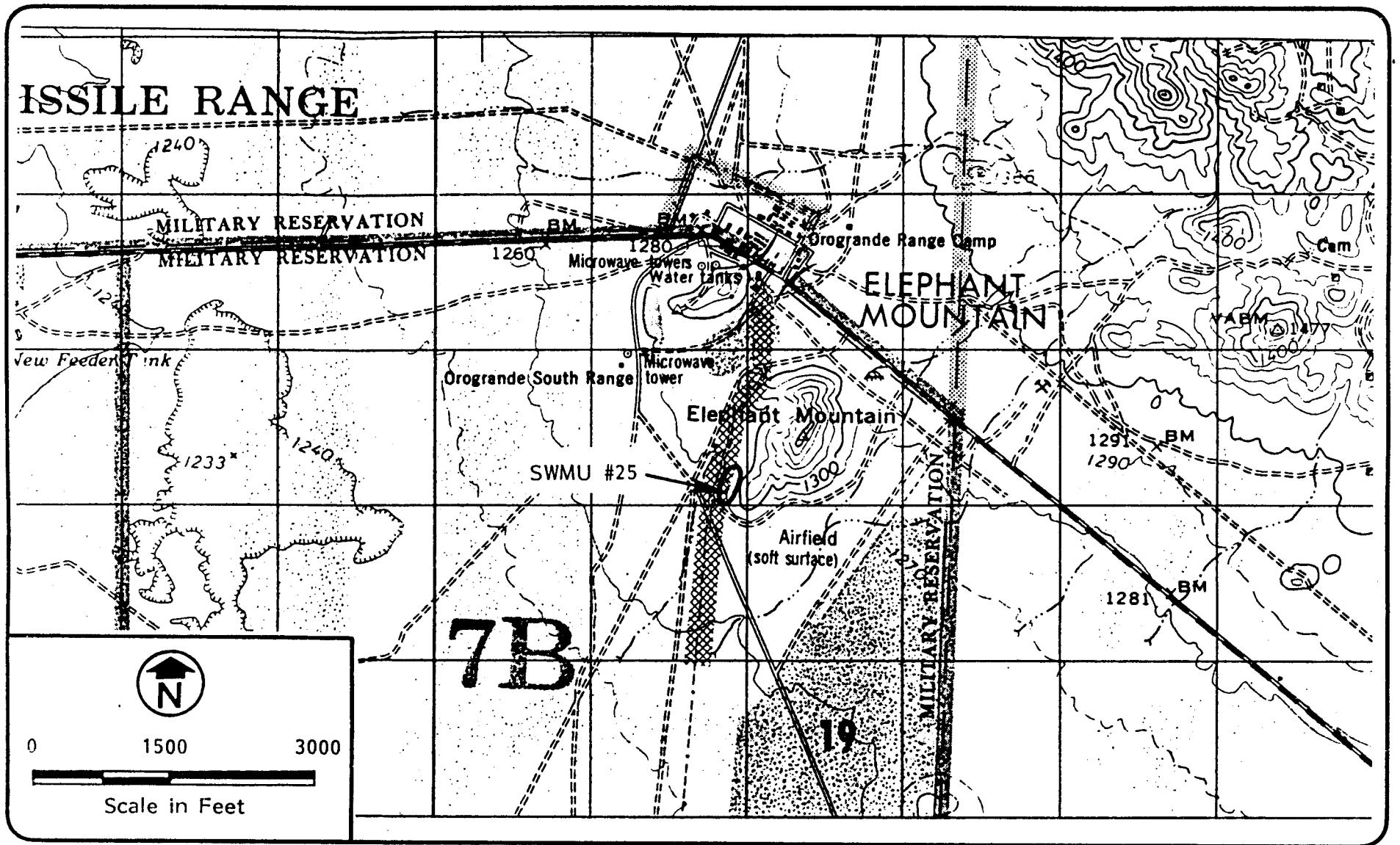

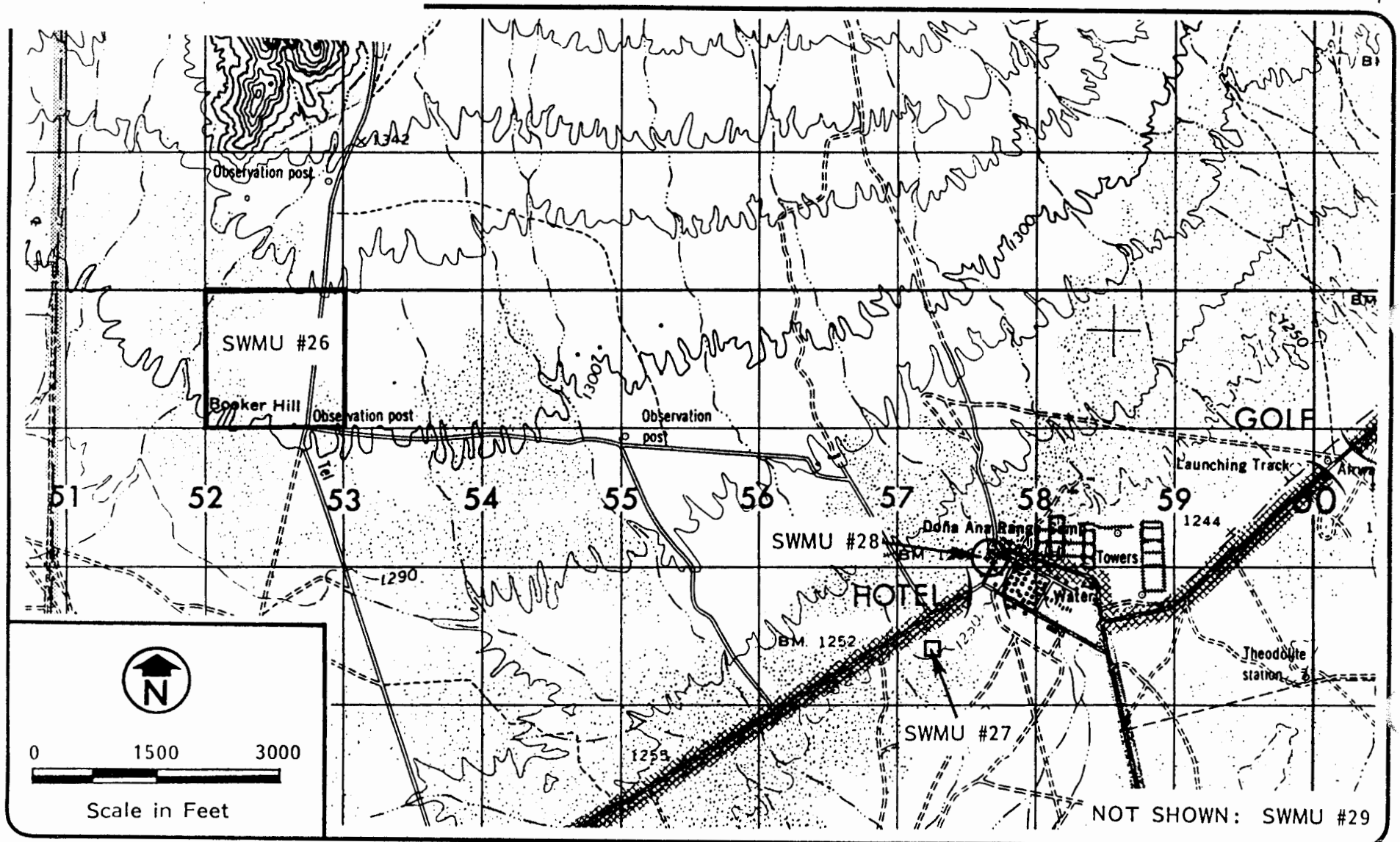

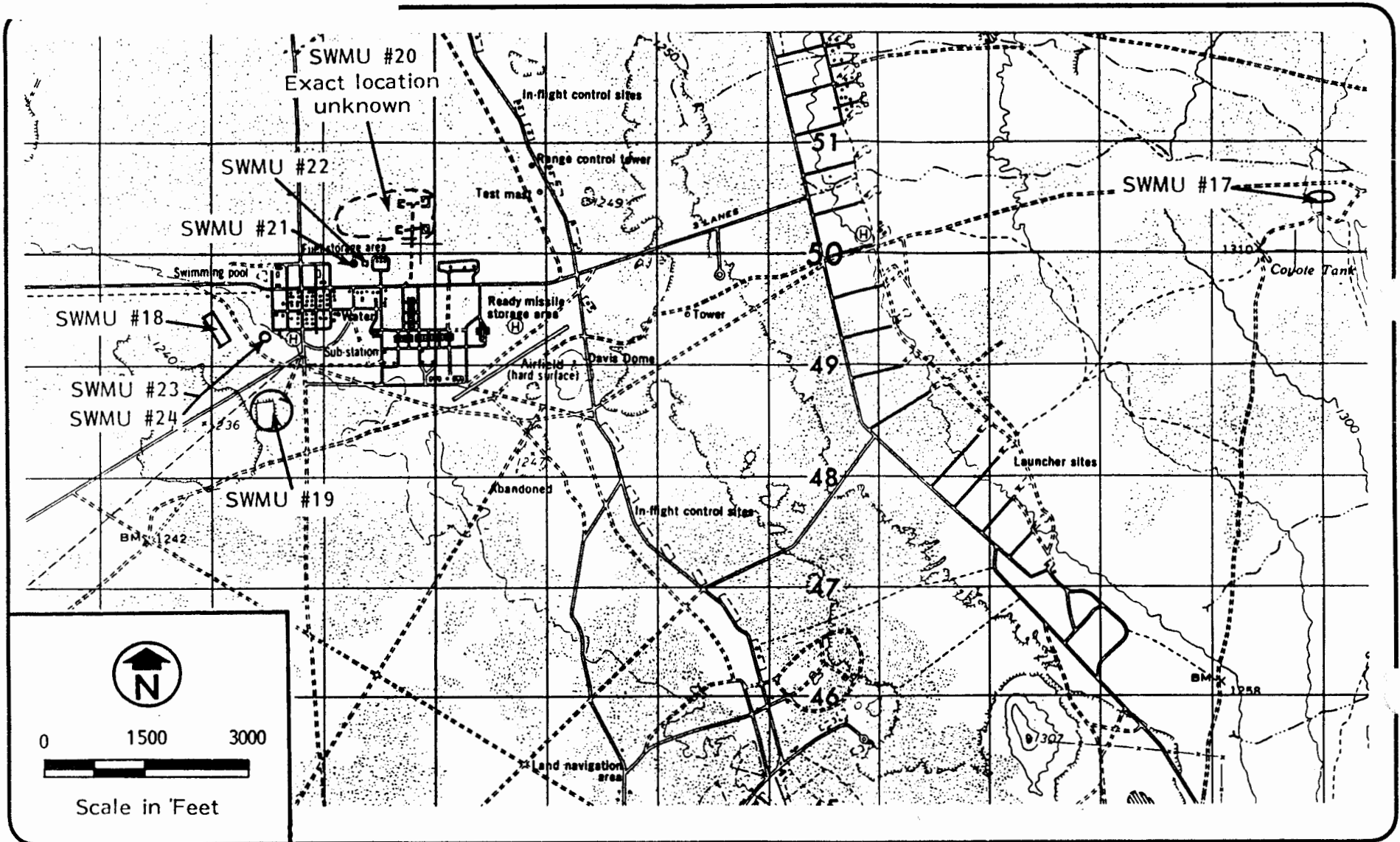

As requested in your letter dated May 24, 1994 the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has completed a review of the U.S. Army Fort Bliss Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) draft permit developed by EPA. Based on a medium to high release potential of hazardous waste contaminants to the environment presented in the March 1989 RCRA Facility Assessment (RFA), and on the fact that most SWMUs have not had sampling conducted at their locations, NMED suggests that EPA consider including the following SWMUs on your list requiring RCRA Facility Investigation:
