Dear Concerned Citizen,


You are hereby informed that the Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) of the New Mexico Environment Department has, at the request of the U.S. Army Air Defense Artillery Center and Fort Bliss extended the Public Comment period for the Fort Bliss Open Burn/Open Detonation (OB/OD) draft Permit by 30 days. The public comment period shall now officially end on November 16, 1994, and not on October 16, 1994 as stated in HRMB's letter to you that was dated August 26, 1994.
