Dear General Cravens:

On March 21, 22, and 23, 1995 the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) conducted a hazardous waste inspection of your facility, U.S. Army Air Defense Artillery Center and Ft Bliss (USAADACFB). Based on a review of the information obtained, NMED has determined that USAADACFB has violated the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Fee Regulations (AHWFR-1). The purpose of this letter is to delineate the violation in writing and to require USAADACFB to comply with AHWFR-1.

The violation is:

1. At the time of the inspection, USAADACFB had not paid the annual hazardous waste fees for calendar year 1993. This is a violation of AHWFR-1, Part V.

Since the inspection, NMED has received the hazardous waste fees. Therefore, no further action is required of USAADACFB with regards to this violation.


