



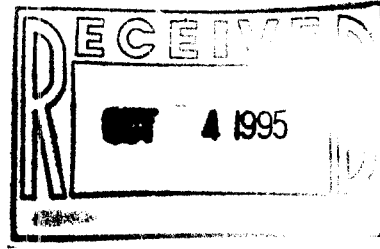


Dear Ms. Hoditschek:

Enclosed for your review and approval is an amendment to our Part A Hazardous Waste Permit Application (Permit Number NM4213720101-01). The revised Part A Application requests an increase in the amount of waste treated annually from 1373<sup>2</sup> pounds per year to 10,000 pounds per year (net explosive weight).

Unfortunately, records of waste quantities treated at the open detonation (OD) pit in the past are virtually non-existent. After much discussion with our Safety Office, Ammunition Surveillance Office, and the 41st EOD officer, our best estimate for the maximum waste treated at the OD pit may reach 10,000 per year.
