2002 Meeting, 24 to 26 April 2001

1. You are invited to participate in the Fort Bliss Installation Action Plan meeting to be held in El Paso, Texas, Wednesday and Thursday, 25, & 26 April 2001. The meeting will be held in a hotel near the post and accommodation information will be sent to you directly by the company supporting us in this effort, on or before 26 March 2001.
2. Others attending this meeting will be the Fort Bliss IRP team, TRADOC IRP representatives, the USAEC program manager for Fort Bliss representatives from the environmental regulatory departments of Texas, and civilian contractors who are involved in restoration work at the post.
3. The agenda will include detailed review of every aspect of the restoration efforts on each open DERA site at Fort Bliss. Site narratives, recommendations and cost for future clean-up actions, verification of phase completion estimates, review of Records of Decision/Decision Document agreements reached with the appropriate state environmental regulatory agency on each site, verification of the legal driver for the clean up (federal and state), historic document review (if required or appropriate), and review and verification of all exit strategy for each site, including long term monitoring requirements, well abandonment costs, Land Use Controls will be covered in detail for each site. Verification of all cost projections is extremely important. Please come prepared to discuss the status of all documents, reports, closure request, or other actions you have been asked to review and approve on any Fort Bliss sites.
4. The new Installation Action Plan 2001 will be sent to you today via email for your review and use in preparing for this meeting.
