This letter is to inform you that Major General Stanley E. Green replaced Major General Dennis D. Cavin as the Commanding General of Fort Bliss in August 2000. As Commanding General, MG Green is also the officer of the above-referenced permit.

On September 13, 2000, the Fort Bliss Directorate of Environment (DOE) submitted an Amendment to the Part A Application for the OD Unit Permit. 


