

Steve, I haven't forgotten you. Our Range Liaison still hasn't replied about visiting the OD site on November 17 (or 16), but I'll nag him. Our GIS program manager said he would provide a Powerpoint version of the range map that shows safety fans for various munitions. I'll send that as soon as I get it. And I asked the folks who manage the Ammunition Supply Point to send an SOP, which I will forward to you. Also asked them your questions about Condition Code H.

Our EOD Unit isn't back from vacation, but in early November, I'll ask them how they determine installation boundaries in the event something goes off range.

When you looked through the EOD's disposal log, you asked if you could get a picture of a "lee" stinger. After reexamining the log, we determined that it doesn't say "lee" stinger - it says "1ea" stinger (meaning 1 each).
