The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the Department of Army's (Permittee) *Report of Annual Post-Closure Site Inspection; McGregor Range Camp Landfill (SWMU 18/FTBL-013)* (Report), dated December 17, 2009.

The Permittee has fulfilled its obligation to conduct an annual inspection in 2009 and submit an annual report to NMED. The requirement to conduct annual inspections of the McGregor Range Rubble Pit Landfill (SWMU 18) is included in NMED's letter dated June 12, 2007.



The review of this Report indicates that the inspection was conducted in accordance with the requirements described in the above mentioned letter. Native vegetation growth was observed at the SWMU. No erosion damage was detected at the SWMU. A portion of the fence surrounding SWMU 18 was found broken. The fence was repaired. Additionally, an approximate 30-foot section of the fence at SWMU 18 was moved to facilitate a dirt trail between SWMU 18 and the perimeter of the cantonment for use by security vehicles in patrolling the cantonment.

The Permittee must continue annual inspections of the McGregor Range Rubble Pit Landfill (SWMU 18) and submit an annual report documenting the results of inspection to NMED no later than December 31, 2010.
