The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received Fort Bliss's *Wastewater Sampling Results Report for September 2021 Semi-Annual Wastewater Compliance Sampling for Meyer and Doña Ana – New Mexico Range Outfalls*, dated October 6, 2021 and received November 5, 2021. 
