RE: Corrective Actions Management Unit (CAMU) Proposal to Add Two Additional Treatment Cells and Additional Burn Pan
Fort Wingate Depot Activities, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Kieling:

Please let this letter serve as proposal to construct two of the three contingent treatment cells and additional burn pan to the existing Corrective Action Management Unit (CAMU) located on Fort Wingate Depot Activities (FWDA), New Mexico.

The purpose of this request is due to an increase in activities that will take place starting in the fall of 2016. Currently, US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) has one contractor on site completing Waste Military Munitions (WMM) clearance activities. There will be an additional contractor arriving on site in the fall of 2016 to conduct WMM clearance operations in the Hazardous Waste Management Unit (HWMU). The request is to construct and use the two additional treatment cells and burn pan to meet requirements of the separate contractors that will be using the FWDA CAMU.

The additional treatment cells will be constructed in accordance with Section IX.B.2 Treatment Cell Design and the burn pan in accordance with Section IX.B.3, RCRA Permit EPA No. NM6213820974. USACE Contractors will abide by all requirements within the RCRA permit Section IX for treatment of WMM and combine use will not exceed RCRA Permit limitations, i.e. only one cell use at a time and will not exceed 1,000 lbs. net explosive weight (NEW) to be treated in any seven day period.

It is USACE's intent to request approval of this proposal and have the newly awarded contractor to construct and utilize the two additional treatment cells. Location of proposed treatment cells are on the attached map.

The Army respectfully requests your review and decision as soon as possible.


