The Department of the Army respectfully submits this notification of its intention to perform the January 2020 quarterly static groundwater level measurements in accordance with the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Permit, EPA ID# NM6213820974 Section V.I.B5 issued by the New Mexico Environment Department on February 25, 2015.

The Army will collect static groundwater levels from northern area groundwater wells and piezometers and perform routine well maintenance. The static groundwater level measurement event will take place beginning January 13, 2019. The event will take approximately one week to complete.
