Dear Mr. Pache,

This letter briefly summarizes the points discussed between the NEIP, GE and EPA at the meeting of November 20, 1984, at your office.

It is my understanding that by January 6, 1985, GE will supply the state with a reasonably detailed closure plan for the subsurface impoundment. If the plan is acceptable to the state, the company will proceed with the closure at a schedule approved by your office.

Regarding the subject compliance order, it is expected that GE will pay the suggested fine of \$4700 & EPA will be able to close the order. In any case, the company's attorney will get in touch with our attorney, Lucinda Watson, and the compliance order will be resolved to the satisfaction of the State and EPA.
