




As per Section 206.C.2.F of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations, GE is submitting this letter to comply with the closure requirements of the four areas described in the GE Closure Plan (November 1983). These areas have been inspected and analyzed by Roy F. Weston, Inc. The results of three of the areas are available in the report, "Determination of Soil Contamination at the General Electric Hazardous Waste Storage Facilities," October 1984, and in a letter of inspection dated November 27, 1984, for the Empty Container Storage Area. All four of these areas have been determined to be free of contamination.

Attached is the letter from your office stating that the closure report results were reviewed and no additional clean-up activity would be necessary to complete closure with the exception of this certification. Therefore, we, the undersigned, certify that closure of the GE storage facilities is complete in accordance with the GE Closure Plan of November 1983.



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

NOTICE OF INTENT TO TERMINATE INTERIM STATUS AND TO CLOSE LONG - TERM (GREATER THAN 90 - DAY) STORAGE AREAS FOR HAZARDOUS WASTE

Under authority of the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (§ 74-4-1 et. seq. NMSA 1978) and the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-2), the New Mexico Environmental Improvement Division (EID) proposes to terminate the interim status of General Electric Company's Albuquerque Plant, EPA I.D. Number NMD052684578, located at 336 Woodward Road, S.E., Albuquerque, New Mexico and to approve a closure plan for the long-term (greater than 90-day) storage areas at that site. General Electric Company's Woodward facility is involved in the manufacture of aircraft engine parts and has conducted long term storage of hazardous wastes associated with those manufacturing processes.

The decision to terminate interim status is based on General Electric Company's request to withdraw its Part A application for a hazardous waste storage permit because, as a result of changes in its operations and a re-evaluation of their wastes, the Company will no longer be subject to the requirements of HWMR-2, Sections 206, 301, 302 and 303 for the storage of hazardous wastes. Termination of interim status is to be accomplished through permit denial. The cause for this permit denial is a request by the Company and does not suggest any wrongdoing on the part of the Company.

The proposed closure plan describes the procedures to be used to remove all waste from, and decontaminate existing storage areas.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed termination of interim status or upon the proposed closure plan, or who wish to request a public hearing, should submit such comments and requests in writing to the New Mexico Health and Environment Department, Environmental Improvement Division, P.O. Box 968, 725 St. Michael's Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-0968, ATTENTION: Peter H. Pache. Requests for a public hearing shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. These comments and/or requests must be received no later than August 1, 1984 to be considered.

The administrative record for these decisions consist of a permit application (Part A), a "notice of intent to terminate interim status", a fact sheet, a closure plan, and related correspondence. The administrative record may be reviewed at either the EID District Office, 4215-4219 Montgomery Blvd., N.E., Albuquerque, New Mexico or the EID Central Office, 725 St. Michael's Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

All written comments submitted on the proposed termination of interim status and/or the proposed closure plan will be considered in formulating a final decision. The EID will notify General Electric Company and each person who submitted a written comment during the public comment period of the final decisions, or of any public hearing which may be scheduled.

If, after consideration of all written comments, these proposed actions become EID's final decisions, EID will issue to General Electric Company a Notice of Termination, immediately terminating the interim status of the Company's facility. The Notice of Termination will require that the Company's closure activities be performed in conformity with applicable State law, as well as within the terms of the Company's closure plan.
