Pursuant to our telephone conversation of April 26, 1990, this letter is to serve as concurrence on the monitoring parameters for the GE Apparatus Shop. It is my understanding that a letter will be forthcoming from yourself outlining the parameters, but in general the monitoring will consist primarily of the SW 846, Method 8020 parameters and some of the base neutral extractables.

Based on the current information, EID would not require any additional monitoring for closure activities. However, as new information becomes available or after the closure plan submitted by GE is reviewed, it may be necessary to require additional samples.
