
SUBJECT: Installation Restoration Program at Holloman Air Force Base (HAFB)/Draft Remedial Investigation Report

1. We are providing, under separate cover, two (2) copies of the Draft Remedial Investigation Report for multiple sites at Holloman Air Force Base. This document is the culmination of field work and in-depth study of 10 sites determined from the Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Records Search for HAFB dated August 1983.
2. A review meeting has been scheduled at HAFB, Building 55 (civil engineering), for Tuesday, 3 October 1989 at 9:00 a.m. As discussed in a phone conversation between our Sharon Moore, Base Environmental Coordinator, and yourself on 17 August 1989, we would like to have the New Mexico Environmental Improvement Division participate in our meeting to provide comments and recommendations.
