Memo to file from BRUCE SWANTON



Sharon Moore of HAFB environmental section called this afternoon reporting that neither the Missouri River Division (MRD) nor Radian analyses turned up any pcb's in the retest of all RCRA wells at HAFB.

I told Ms. Moore that EID's likely response to this in the case that 1) HAFB were to attempt to clean close its sewage lagoons or 2) EID found itself in a position to make a recommendation regarding to continued use of the lagoons during dispute resolution, that EID would have to collect samples itself and submit them to its own lab for an independent confirmation of the lack of pcb's in HAFB's groundwater.

I called Court Fesmire and left a message for him to return my call regarding HAFB pcb's.

Court returned my call. I informed him of the new data and of EID's likely position (see above).

I inquired about EPA's proposed letter to HAFB requiring a new closure plan. He told me that the draft letter was in "concurrence", the process whereby proposed correspondence is evaluated by the chain of authority, and that Allyn Davis would hopefully be signing off on it this week.
