Groundwater Data: from year's complete data. Sig Diff in TOC between upgradient well MW-1 and seven of the eight downgradient wells. HAFB did not show this difference because they used erroneous data from the first months sampling. These samples were very much higher in TOC than is normal for groundwater. Also, EPA's analysis did not show this high value. EPA also has problems with PCB's. They do not have any data following the run wherein PCB's.

Apparently the EPA CME report of 2/90 suggested EID act on the significant TOC findings to require HAFB to go into assessment.

EID will require adequate verification that groundwater is not contaminated with RCRA contaminants, so it currently appears that EID will have to pursue an assessment at HAFB.

EPA has found out that TAC's attorney will be their primary spokesperson at the currently scheduled 1/31 meeting. EPA is just now trying to line up an attorney to come to the meeting. If they can't, the meeting will be postponed again.
