SUBJECT: Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Meeting-Dallas, Tx

1. A meeting to discuss past, present, and future actions on Holloman AFB Installation Restoration Program (IRP) sites is scheduled for 9 December 1991, 0900, at EPA Region VI in Dallas, TX. Many of our IRP sites are also Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and are listed in our RCRA facility permit for investigation and, if required, corrective action. Our completed work to date, under the IRP program, will be presented to EPA in place of the work plan required by the RCRA Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments portion of the base's facility permit.
2. Holloman AFB environmental staff personnel have been in contact with Mr David Morgan, Ground Water Protection and Remediation Bureau, Dr Bruce Swanton and Mr Joe Kennedy, Hazardous and Radioactive Waste Bureau, discussing various sites. We have asked these people to attend this meeting, as we believe it will aid us in the coordination and communication between all federal and state offices involved with site restoration.
3. The Department of Defense has a Memorandum of Agreement with the State of New Mexico which allows for reimbursement of funds spent for oversight of our IRP program. We believe this travel and per diem expenses are reimbursable under this agreement. We encourage you to investigate the possibility of utilizing these funds for travel expenses.
4. Early involvement, among all interested parties, in decisions related to the IRP program, will preclude redundant work in the future. We appreciate your interest and look forward to meeting with you in Dallas. If you have any questions, please call Mrs Sharon Moore at 479-3931.
