SUBJ: Oil Pollution Act (OPA) of 1990 Requirements

1. Holloman AFB has a Petroleum, Oil, and Lubricant (POL) storage capacity of over one million gallons and, therefore, the installation will be required under the Oil Pollution Act (OPA) to develop and maintain a comprehensive spill prevention, containment, and countermeasure plan. Due to other regulations, the base has already developed a Disaster Preparedness Operations Plan (Atch 1) and a Spill Prevention and Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Plan (Atch 2). These plans address the necessary concerns as required by the OPA. In anticipation of the pending regulation (40 CFR 112/Proposed Rule) to implement the OPA, a copy of both the Disaster Preparedness Operations Plan and the Spill Prevention and Hazardous Material Emergency Response Plan are forwarded for your review.

2. Request an evaluation of our plans and a written response notifying Holloman AFB if the plans meet the requirements of the OPA.
