SUBJECT: Holloman AFB (HAFB) Sites Subject to Resource Conservation and
Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit Review

1. We would like to extend an invitation to your RCRA Permits Program personnel to visit Holloman AFB (HAFB) to inspect sites for which permits are currently under review, including the lagoons, Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (Temporary Storage Disposal Facility), and the two open-burn/open-detonation units. We believe such a visit will aid in your review of the permit applications by providing first-hand knowledge of the unique aspects of the regulated units and of the HAFB environment.

2. This visit will be funded by the Air Force, using funds designated specifically for an exchange program between HAFB and NMED. Travel expenses, lodging and per diem for meals and miscellaneous expenses will be provided. Travel plans must be complete by the end of July 1994 but the visit may occur later. We suggest you may want to schedule the visit to coincide with the fall field sampling activities.

3. The information needed to complete the travel arrangements includes the names and social security numbers of the travelers and the dates and duration of the visit, including travel days. We will coordinate the details of transportation and lodging arrangements over the phone.
