**RE: Class Determination, Fee, and Information submittal for a  
RCRA Permit Modification - Container Storage Unit (DRMO)**

Dear Mr. Moffitt:

Holloman Air Force Base's request to modify several items in the permit were received by our office on October 15, 1994 (letter dated 10/22/94). As indicated in the letter, structural changes to the container storage unit (DEMO) are to be handled as the first and as a separate permit modification. Permit modification for the additional items will to be addressed at some later date initiated by HAFB.

We have received your June 8, 1994 response to questions dealing with construction activity associated with rebuilding the outdoor container storage area (concrete slab and containment curb) and the installation of a roof over the outside storage area. From our review of design plans received, a determination has been made to classify these activities under a class 1 permit modification. The only noted change in the design of the container storage pad was the addition of a sealed expansion joint. This particular type of modification does not require prior approval. As long as construction is completed as indicated, the permit modification fee is received, permit text changes are submitted and mailing list notification is completed, no delays will be encumbered by our office.

In accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Fee Regulations (HWFR-1), a fee of \$1000.00 is required for review and classification of the requested permit modification. A billing statement is attached to this letter. Please send a check, payable to the address indicated on the statement.


This fee must be paid within thirty (30) calendar days of your receipt of this letter. Failure to pay the fee within this period may result in a revocation of the RCRA permit.

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In order to incorporate new information resulting from the outdoor storage area construction, the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) will also need the requested text changes for Permit Attachment B of the permit. Since text changes will be inserted into the Permit Attachment, page numbering will be affected. Please submit the entire modified Permit Attachment on a 3-1/2 inch computer disk, formatted for Word Perfect 5.2 along with appropriate drawings. After NMED approves text changes, you will need to notify all persons on the attached mailing list in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Regulations (HWMR-6), Part IX, §270.42(a)(ii). The proposed modification and mailing list notification must be completed within 90 days after the final permit modification will be incorporated into the Permit. You will receive a copy of the modification after we receive your payment and changes are approved.
