Dear Ms. Gibin:

This letter acknowledges the receipt of your air quality permit application dated September 7, 1994 to construct a vacuum enhanced pumping soil remediation unit near Alamogordo, New Mexico. The application was received by the Department on October 11, 1994.

Based on a preliminary review of the information provided and your letter of November 3, 1994 we have determined that you are exempt from the provisions of Air Quality Control Regulation 702. Therefore, a permit is not required.

We have also determined that new source performance standards (NSPS) or national emission standards for hazardous air pollutants (NESHAPS) do not apply to this facility.

In the event there is a change in control or ownership of the facility U.S. Air Force - Holloman Air Force Base shall notify the Department in writing within fifteen (15) days of that change.
